NO LIFEGUARD – SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

GENERAL POOL RULES

Please read the following pool rules carefully. These rules have been put in place to protect the Homeowners so that everyone can have a safe and enjoyable summer!

1. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older. Individuals must have an access card and can bring up to four (4) guests, with a maximum number of four (4) guests per household. Five (5) or more guests are considered a party and must have prior approval.
2. Parents are responsible for infants, children under the age of 12, and non-swimmers while in the pool area.
3. NO SOLO SWIMMING at any time.
4. All swimmers must wear proper swimming attire. NO cut-offs, dungarees or Bermudas. Please do not swim in regular clothes.
5. Individuals with incontinence problems or those that are not toilet trained, should wear rubber pants when in the pool and pool area.
6. If a person has a “sanitary accident” in the pool, please tell the monitor (when present) immediately so that we are able to take proper safety precautions.
7. No bathing in pool. The pool is for recreational purposes ONLY.
8. Showering prior to entering the pool is required.
9. NO RUNNING, boisterous activity, rough play, horseplay, wrestling, dunking, chicken fighting and/or water guns are allowed in the pool area.
10. NO DIVING or flipping off of the edges into the pool allowed due to shallow water.
11. NO GLASS allowed in pool area.
12. NO skateboards, scooters, roller blades, or bicycles are allowed in the pool area.
13. No pets are allowed in the pool area. Variances will be granted for this rule to comply with Federal and State Laws regarding individuals with disabilities
14. NO RAFTS or boats are permitted in any pool without prior approval. Noodles are allowed.

15. NO SPITTING or blowing nose in pool.
16. NO SMOKING allowed in the pool area. The use of e-cigarettes is also prohibited.
17. Persons with skin infections, eye infections, ear infections, nasal infections, open wounds, or communicable diseases are not allowed in pool.
18. Lifeguards are not on duty: SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
19. Insubordination, foul/offensive language, refusing to listen to any lifeguard/monitor and/or disrespectful behavior towards any staff or member can result in immediate suspension without any prior offenses. Refusal to leave the property will result in suspension of pool privileges and family pass card will be deactivated.
20. Anyone allowing non-members (or members with suspended pass card privileges) into the pool area is subject to loss of pool privileges.
21. Anyone caught propping the gate open is subject to loss of pool privileges. Propping the gate open is not only a security issues, but also a safety issue, and could cause the pool to be closed by the County.
22. ALL members are asked to properly dispose of trash and police the area.
23. Please keep the pool furniture away from the edge of the pool and out of the walkways. Pool furniture is not to be placed inside the pool at any time.
24. If you are the last to leave the pool area, please close all umbrellas and secure the gate.

The Homeowners Association reserves the right and responsibility to close the pool(s) when deemed necessary. All pool staff/monitors have full authority to enforce these rules and regulations.

Homeowners who are not current on their dues will have their pass card deactivated.

BY ENTERING THE POOL AREA YOU ARE AGREEING TO ALL OF THESE CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS.

An emergency phone is located on the wall of the Clubhouse between the two bathrooms. This phone is to be used for emergency purposes only and may NOT be used to make personal calls.
